## **SERVING OTHERS**

Imagine this.

You're in the line at Scooter's Coffee for your daily extra-whipped double caramel super duper frappuccino latte (I'm just assuming that's a real drink as I just drink my coffee black). The line is long and you need to be at work in 5 minutes. But you need your coffee. You start to get frustrated that it's taking so long. 3 and a half minutes later, you finally pull up to the window ready to grab your cup, pay for the much needed caffeine, and speed off to the office, but the cashier says you don't owe anything - the person ahead of you paid for your drink.

Huh?

Or here's another example. You're about to spend the next hour and a half mowing your lawn on the hottest Saturday of August, because it's already way too long, yet you have a million other things to do because your life is crazy, because everyone's life is crazy these days. Mowing the lawn is the last thing you want to be doing right now. But you put your adult, lawn-mowing pants on and head outside to find that your neighbor, whom you barely talk to, has taken the initiative and mowed your lawn for you, no strings attached. You head on over to their front door to ask them why they would do that, and they respond "no reason - I just felt like that was a way I could bless you. Jesus calls us to serve others with no strings attached."

Huh? Maybe you could tell me more...?

When you serve other people, with no strings attached, at the very least the people are left feeling blessed. At the most, they inquire about why you would do such a thing, opening the door to perhaps a more spiritual conversation. This is what Jesus modeled and what He now calls us to. Think of when Jesus washed his disciple's feet. They were very confused. When Jesus went to wash Peter's feet, his response in the ESV translation is "Lord, do you wash my feet?" You can easily visualize Peter's confusion. What Jesus modeled went against the culture of the time, just as no-strings-attached service goes against the culture today. Because of what Jesus did 2,000 years ago, we can join in on the good news. We have the opportunity to metaphorically (or even literally) wash people's feet and be an example of what it is to follow Jesus.


## **SERVING OTHERS**
